General information

- Forscope provides this documentation for **Microsoft perpetual software products**. Licenses from other software manufacturers come with different types of documentation.
- There is no official template for the visual look of the documentation, that's why it might differ in terms of graphic design. However, the factual content is always the same and confirms the fulfilment of legally required conditions for the transfer of software ownership.

Sample documentation legend

Numbers in colored circles showed throughout this document correspond to the respective EU law requirement, which you can find stated below:

- 1 The first country of usage was within EU/EEA, or Switzerland.
- 2 The product was paid in full to the copyright owner.
- 3 The product is perpetual with no time limit for use.
- 4 The product is no longer in use by the first owner.

These points confirm the 4 legal requirements...

the company **Forscope a.s.** with its registered office at Lidická 960/81, Veveří, 602 00 Brno, Czech Republic, Company ID: 048 85 414, entered in the Commercial Register kept by the Regional Court in Brno, Section B, Insert 8720 (hereinafter referred to as the **“Seller”**) declares that pursuant to the Directive 2009/24/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 23 April 2009 on the legal protection of computer programs, as amended, every copy of a computer program (hereinafter referred to as the **“Products”**) provided by the Seller to any natural or legal person (hereinafter referred to as the **“Buyer”**) meets the below criteria for the exhaustion of distribution rights within the territory of the European Union.

1. The offered Products have been put into circulation with the copyright holder’s consent within the territory of the European Union, the European Economic Area, or Switzerland.
2. The seller has not concluded any ancillary agreements with software manufacturers that would affect the intended use of the Products.
3. The copyright holder has received full remuneration for the Products during the first sale.
4. The Seller is the sole legal owner of all offered Products.
5. All Products are perpetual, with no time limit for use.
6. All Products can be used by companies and organizations from both the **private and public sectors**.
7. Products are no longer in use by any user; previous owner(s) have uninstalled or made the Products unusable for themselves.

1. This part confirms the legal condition that the software product's **first country of usage** was within EU/EEA, or Switzerland.

2. If there is a software audit in an organization, then based on the **License Agreement number**, the auditor locates the contract between the first license owner and the copyright holder. The License Agreement contains all information regarding the first purchase of the product, which the auditor is able to access.

3. The **product name** in combination with the **License Agreement type** provide proof the purchased software product is perpetual with no time limit for use. The License Agreement type can be any of the Microsoft Volume distribution channel ones.



4 First owner declaration

The document on the following page shows the First owner declaration confirming all necessary legal requirements were met by the former owner. If the parts containing identification information are covered, it means they are protected under the NDA (Non-disclosure agreement), or GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation) and can't be displayed to third parties. The only exception is during an audit – if the auditor requests access to additional information, our company can provide it to him/her.

4. Among other legally required information, the **First owner declaration** also includes the **Declaration of uninstallation** proving the software product(s) are no longer used by the first owner.
